NOTES

- 1) With the exception of Dead, Dying, or Hazardous (DDH) Trees, LMMNA is responsible for all tree removal, including permitting and recompense plantings. The City of Atlanta will remove DDH trees as determined by the City of Atlanta Arborist. Trees will be cut as close to the ground as possible. 2) NO improvements, other than approved plantings per GEMA approved landscape proposal, dated July 1, 2013, shall involve soil disturbance greater than 6 inches in depth. This includes footings for benches and fences.
- 3) Construction details for all structures including benches, fences, raised garden beds, and compost area structures must be submitted to the City of Atlanta for approval prior to construction. 4) Planting plans and species lists must be submitted to the City of Atlanta for approval prior to
- 5) Existing Water Meter to be switched to an Irrigation Only Meter. Final location for Backflow Preventer and Water Tap to be approved by Department of Watershed Management.
